



APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Apply via volunteer form on website
- 2. Confirmation email of received application
- 3. Email with registration link for short interview
- 4. Interview (January & Feburary)
- 5. Final decision via email

GENERAL INFORMATION



For full access to all days of the event, volunteers will have shifts that comprise around 15h of work. These hours can also be collected during the preparation/dismantling phase before and after the event. If you are only available on one day, we will try to make it work but applicants who have more availability will be favoured.



Volunteers who don't have a Freizeitticket/Snowcard will receive the ski lift ticket at the check-in point at the ski resort. Either when starting the shift or when you have the day off.



Skinnovation will cover your meals during the shifts. You will either get a lunch package or a food voucher for a meal at Hoadl. This depends on your shift location and timing. Please bring a refillable water bottle.



There will be shuttle buses between Innsbruck and the skiing area. Within Innsbruck we expect you to travel independently. If you need to arrive early in the skiing resorts we organize shuttle cars for you and there will be central meeting point in Innsbruck city centre.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Below you will find the description of the individual volunteer tasks. Please read them carefully to be well prepared. If you have further questions, we will answer them during the interview.



PREPARATIONS & DISMANTLING

This task takes place the week before the Event and the day after the event. Your shifts will have various tasks such as preparing materials, collecting sponsoring material and technical gear, allocating tickets, etc. These tasks might not seem too exciting, but remember: If you work your



CHECKIN

You will be the first contact point for our participants, give them a warm welcome to Skinnovation 2024! Also, you are the main contact person for all inquiries at the skiing resort.

Your tasks include:

- ID check for identification
- · keep track of the participant list
- hand out goodies + accreditation
- explain program and answer questions



SKI HUTS

Volunteers at the ski huts are mainly responsible to support the talks taking place at the ski huts as well as supporting th hosted lunch tables

GENERAL TASKS INCLUIDE

- setting up the location, e.g. tables, chairs, flags, rollups, attaching (a lot of) signposts, IT (projector, screen, laptop, pointer)
- welcome speakers, check their accreditation & offer them something to drink
- make sure that the IT works & help with the setup of the presentation
- check the door and only allow people with a valid accreditation to enter

TABLE HOST TASKS

- preparing the tables
- welcome the participants once they arrive, there is no seating order but first come first serve
- keep track of the time as we have a tight time schedule with lots on the agenda

RESPONSIBILITIES



GONDOLA PITCH

The gondola pitch on Thursday & Friday includes various tasks. Most importantly, you support Hannah, our pitch expert, with the organization and evaluation of the pitch. This year we have two pitching competitons: One is the Hoadlbahn Gondola (later stage startups) and one is in the Olympiabahn (early stage startup). You'll make sure that the investors and startups know where to go, collect evaluation forms and be there for any questions that might arise. Specific tasks will be communicated closer to the event.



PODCAST GONDOLA

Throughout the event, there will be podcasts recorded in the gondola. You will support the podcasts hosts and guests and make sure that they can record without being disturbed. Furthermore you keep track of the timing and communicate with the Skinnovation team and the podcast hosts in case of any problems.



SKI RACE

The Ski race takes place on Friday. You will support the set up of the ski race together with the ski clubs Axams. Once the race started you will explain the Skinnovators the different racing categories, help them to find teams and support the ski club Axams to write down times and teams correctly.



EVENINGS

Assemply/Disassembly of materials at the venue. This includes setting up everything needed for the evening (bar, stage, IT, rollups, etc.)

BAR

You will be providing drinks for our Skinnovators at the bar. You also assist with the set up and deconstruction of the venue and support the catering.

SUPPORT

There will be numerous tasks where we need spontaneous help. This can range from briefings just before the pitch, checking technology, to running small errands.

RESPONSIBILITIES



SHUTTLE DRIVER

We will have cars available to give shuttle rides to some of our speakers. Your task include picking up speakers and bringing them from A to B.



MASCOT - YETI

The Skinnovation mascot is a Yeti - yay!

You have endless power and enthusiasm. After talks you are always ready to take some pictures with our participants and volunteers and show up at all the interesting main point on the schedule.



JUMPER

As the Jumper you will be deployed wherever needed. There will be tasks appearing on short notice, hence make sure that you are reachable over your phone at any time.
